The project proposal should be on A-4 size paper and consist of the following:

- Bio-data of the investigator
- ❖ Background of the proposed idea and novelty with reference to the existing knowledge
- Objective(s) with clearly defined brief methodology
- Outcomes and deliverables
- Budget estimate with break-up
- Endorsement from the Head of the Institution/Organisation (on letter head)
- ❖ A note on the expertise and experiences of the investigator in the relevant area

HOW TO APPLY

Interested researchers, academicians and innovators are invited to submit the project proposal through their respective institutions to the Director, Assam Science Technology & Environment Council (ASTEC), Bigyan Bhawan, G.S. Road, Near IDBI Building, Guwahati-5. The envelope sending the proposal should be superscripted as "S&T Institutional and Human Capacity Building" on the top of the envelope.
